Subject: TESTIMONY EYE INJURY ON 1-31-08 BIAXIAL POWERMAG

Shauna-Li, our 12 yr old, got popped in the eye at lunch during school yesterday, from horsing around with several girls and boys. She claims one of the boy's fingers hit her eye. She didn't go to the office or call home???

We didn't see her until after drama, around 6PM. Her R eye was puffy, the eyeball a little swollen, closed shut 3/4's, upper and lower outer and inner lids were red and swollen, her R cheek red. The inner lower lid was the most swollen and red. She said her R lower inner lid hurt the most, which matched the clinical signs. She iced, I examined for debris or visual cornea abrasions, lashes, etc...

Instead of rushing off to After Hours Care, we used the Power Mag over the R eye. After 5 mins. she said the pain was down. After 10 mins. the pain had calmed down quite a bit. After 25 mins. the R eye was 1/4 closed, swelling almost gone, cheek only slightly red, and she was back in the saddle.

Today, 7:00AM, cheek color within normal limits, (WNL), R eye very slightly smaller in diameter compared to the L eye and no pain. 3:30PM today, she called in and said, "No pain, the eye looks like it is supposed to, Mom".
